RE: Joint Meeting to review FERC Project 2113 License Articles and Plans

On March 8, 2011 WVIC sent a letter to those who may have an interest in participating in consultation regarding aspects of WVIC's Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) license for Project 2113, the Wisconsin River Headwaters Project. The articles included for consultation were:

- Article 401 – Update of the Shoreline Erosion Control Plan
- Article 413/415 – Update of the Fish and Wildlife Management Plan
- Article 420 – Update of the Land Resources Management Plan
- Article 421 – A five-year review of the Operating Plan for the headwaters project

With the March 8 letter we sent a compilation of the applicable articles and promised to send a meeting notice to those expressing an interest in consultation. The enclosed service list indicates the entities responding and having a desire to participate in consultation.

The meeting to accept input will be held on April 19, 2011 in Room 110 A&B at the Westwood Conference Center in Wausau. Directions to the Westwood Center are: exit Hwy 51/39 at Bridge Street (Exit 193), turn west (heading up the hill), turn right at Westwood Dr and right at Westwood Center Blvd, follow and turn right off roundabout to continue onto Westwood Center Blvd. Visitor parking is on the left.

The schedule is provided so that entities may attend only those sessions that apply to their interests if desired. Tentatively, the meeting order will be: **9:00 AM** – Article 401 and Article 420 **10:00 AM** – Article 421 **1:00 PM** – Articles 413/415.

Remember that the enclosed material does not represent the draft plans for which we will seek official written comments referred to in the Articles. They will be mailed to you on or about May 13, 2011 and you will have 30 days to comment. The enclosed plans and data are preliminary and we're primarily seeking direction on additional items that you believe should be addressed within the scope of the Articles.


